Suggestions and Requirements for Live-Virtual Learning

The items below are needed for a successful experience in a Live-Virtual Classroom. Please make certain you have the necessary technology and equipment to participate thoroughly and effectively.

- Computer (PC or Apple)
- Broadband internet access (preferably wired)* ○ *Broadband means minimum speeds equivalent to DSL, satellite, or cable connection of at least 8 mbps. NOTE: wifi connections are typically significantly slower than wired connections.
- Google Chrome web browser
- Webcam
- Head set with microphone or speakers and a microphone
- Keyboard
- A strong, consistent internet connection to stream audio and video in both directions
- Ability to see the full screen and access a keyboard at the same time □ Use of microphone and camera for the duration of the course

- PLEASE DO NOT login from a phone or other small device

- Make certain you can take the course in a Quiet Environment, preferably in a room with no other people present.

- All LIVE-Virtual classes have a 90% attendance policy requirement; no course credit will be awarded if 90% is not met, even due to connectivity issues
